Attraction is The Key

Wasps are a yearly nuisance pest in public places in the height of summer. AgriSense understands the need for professional pest controllers to have an effective system to deal with wasps. That is why we have developed our Dome Trap and Liquid Attractant system which has become the industry standard.

The best method of avoiding problems with wasp is to treat the nest with an approved pesticide. The Dome Trap is however ideal for use in conjunction with such treatments as not all worker wasps may be reached by such treatments and traps will help catch those not affected. If nests cannot be found or wasps are arriving from outside the area, traps can be used to distract wasps away from sensitive public spaces such as gardens, picnic places, restaurants, outdoor eating areas as well as where people work such as offices and food & drink factory environments.

The key to the performance is the liquid attractant which uses the wasp's requirement for sugary, carbohydrate foods against them. Throughout spring, worker wasps are busy preying on other insects, to feed to the developing grubs in the nest and can also be seen collecting nest-building materials. At this time of the year, they are rarely a pest and not often noticed by people.

The problem arises in late summer when the nest brood begins to decline and workers do not find their sugar reward from within the nest and are forced to go hunting for it elsewhere. Invariably, this means they come into contact with people and become a nuisance.





Tips & Techniques in Wasp Trapping

- Place traps in shaded locations suspended from trees, posts or poles as this will offer improved efficiency.
- If the nest location is known, situate the traps between the nest and places where they are considered a problem (such as patio areas) in order to intercept foraging wasps.
- Use a professionally formulated attractant to give the most effective results.
- When treating wasp nests, do so at dusk or early morning when wasps are least active.
- Other traps are bulky, do not collapse into easy transportable kits, and some even recommend the use of beer (what a waste!), other sugary drinks and honey as an attractant. Selecting the professionally developed and tested AgriSense Liquid Bait will save both time and money.
- Check and refill the Liquid Bait regularly as high temperatures can cause evaporation. The liquid attractant can be diluted with water for a period, but when attraction is seen to decline, replace it with fresh liquid.

Disposable Wasp Trap

For a temporary solution or a more discreet trap, AgriSense also offers a Disposable Wasp Trap. This trap utilises the same liquid attractant as the Dome Trap but is designed for temporary use and has less catch potential than the Dome Trap.

Pre-assembled and ready for use, these traps have been designed for small-scale wasp capture, with a period of effective use from 2-3 days,

Wasps are attracted by the Liquid Wasp Attractant, which is held within a sachet inside the trap. Wasps enter and become stuck on the glue coated back panel. It is not intended as a season long or permanent type of trap.
